

I have tried it lid up and down, pushing down on the switch, and when it is supposed to drain mode I hear a click and nothing happens. No sound, nothing. I have blown into the drain hose to see if there is a clog, none so far. I figured this would be a way to test it. **No. The lid switch MUST be functioning (closing its contacts) before the washer will operate. When it fails, its contacts remain open and thus the problem... which would be the same as with the switch removed from the circuit.BTW. Unless you can somehow repair the original, the whole lid switch assembly would usually have to be replaced, yes. They just came apart. I have duct taped the assembly to the underside of the machine. So, it works for now. But, I guess I have to replace the entire assembly.
