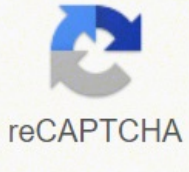




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# Kenmore washer parts diagram

What is needed is the appliance's \*model number\* as printed on the washer's model and serial number tag ("70 Series" isn't it) so we can find out what design of washer it is.You can find tips for locating the model and serial number tag on your appliances in the 'Repair Parts' section of my site linked below.\*\* it will not click over to drain or spin \*\*You mean the timer isn't advancing into the spin cycle (or past it)?If so, that might just be caused by a defective lid switch or lid switch actuator or a possibly problem in the timer.If not, please clarify exactly what is or is not happening and when.Dan O. The timer will not advance to the next cycle (drain, or then to spin). It is a Style Master #909961, Serial #CG383777, Model #110.26712693Thank You. That might just be caused by a defective lid switch or lid switch actuator. Those should be the first things to check.Dan O. Thanks so much for any advise \*\* my machine model # is 22712100 \*\*The complete model number looks to be 110.22712100 making it a Whirlpool built 'direct drive' model.\*\* the problem I'm having is getting the top off so that I can replace the [lid switch]. \*\*I would imagine you would have trouble there since the top is NOT designed to come off of that design of washer. The whole cabinet is removed (or just tilted forward) for most internal component service (see the following link). - Removing the cabinet on a Direct Drive washer.... The timer moves along no problem. Only when we get to the drain point it does nothing. I have tried it lid up and down, pushing down on the switch, and when it is supposed to go to drain mode I hear a click and nothing happens. No sound, nothing. I have blown into the drain hose to see if there is a clog, none so far.Is this also a switch issue? \*\* Is this also a switch issue? \*\*If the timer stop moving at that point and never moves further on its own, the switch is a possibility... depending on the exact model of washer in question ("70 Series" isn't it).You can find tips for locating the model number identification tag on your appliances in the 'Repair Parts' section of my web site linked below.Dan O. Does this mean it is not the lid switch, or should I bridge the connection to test, unlike what the other poster said? \*\* According to some other poster, if you removed it, it would start working. I figured this would be a way to test it. \*\*No. The lid switch MUST be functioning (closing its contacts) before the washer will operate. When it fails, its contacts remain open and thus the problem... which would be the same as with the switch removed from the circuit.BTW. Do I have to buy the ENTIRE switch assembly? \*\*The lid switch is only sold as a single part. Unless you can somehow repair the original, the whole lid switch assembly would usually have to be replaced, yes. All it does is make a buzzing noise almost like the motor is running but can't go any where. It stops then goes again until it finally gets to the done/off but there is still water in the tank. Hello, My 70 series Kenmore washer also will not advance. My machine model # is 110.82370800. The washer seems to working on all functions except I need to manually advance the timer knob or it will stay the same place and runs forever.
